Pam was one of several KWAOR REALTORS® nominated by KWAOR members for the 2020 REALTOR® of the Year Award. Nominees must submit written applications for consideration and are chosen by past KWAOR Realtor of the Year honorees.

A member of the Kent Washington Association since 2016, Pam has provided distinguished leadership service to this Association. A current KWAOR Director, Executive Committee and Community Outreach Committee member, Pam also co-chairs KWAOR's REALTOR® Relief Task Force which spearheaded the Association's COVID-19 support efforts for members and our community. Her past KWAOR service includes leading the KWAOR Community Outreach Committee as co-chair from 2017 to 2019, during which time the Committee significantly expanded the Association's positive impact and visibility in the community. Pam established KWAOR's REALTOR Hero® award program and served on the KWAOR Education Committee from 2016-2018. She is also a longtime member of the Greater Providence Board of REALTORS® and served on their Grievance Committee from 2003-2008.

At the State level, Pam chaired the Rhode Island Association of Realtors (RIAR) Realtor Political Action Committee (RPAC) in 2017 and 2018, and served two years on the State Risk Management Committee. Pam is an active pre-licensing class instructor for RIAR, and a Subject Matter Expert (SME) for Pearson Vue testing services; she creates material for both the Rhode Island and National (general) real estate exams.

At the National level, Pam is currently serving the second of a two-year appointment to the NAR Insurance Committee. She has also served one year on the NAR RPAC Participation Council. She has regularly attended regional and national conferences over the past several years.

Pam's leadership and philanthropy extend beyond her profession. She currently serves on the Board of Directors of the Greater Providence YMCA and is an active volunteer with the American Red Cross and RI Pride. She is a past Board Member and past Board Chair of Rhode Island's Looking Glass Theatre. Pam served seven years as a working member of the 103rd Field Artillery Division (US Army) Family Support while her husband Chris Carbone served in the RI National Guard. In 2006 she was honored with the Molly Pitcher Award for Service to the Armed Forces, the highest civilian award given by the US Army.
